Duration: 60 mins

Topic: Gender equality – Breaking free from societal expectations

#### **Learning objectives:**

By the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- 1. use the present tense to talk about gender stereotypes in their daily lives and the changes they would like to see; and
- 2. show increased gender awareness and respect for everyone regardless of their sex.

### **Synopsis:**

Why are there differences between boys and girls? In school, girls usually queue at the front ahead of boys. Girls are often asked to design the board for the inter-class board display competition, and boys are expected to join football matches. Can you think of other examples? Should these differences be stopped?

#### Moral:

It is important for everyone to develop their abilities to the full. Everyone should be treated equally, regardless of their sex.
